

## EUROPE

### Belgium

- **ARGEA (SADE)** : connection between the Andenne and Ohey reservoirs. This drinking water supply pipe includes the laying of 9,300 m of PN 16 and PN 25 steel pipes in DN 600 as well as 1,020 m of DN 200 to 250 mm pipes. 80 m of pipes will be laid under rivers – €9.6m
- **ARGEA (SADE)** : section n°2 for the construction of the Villers-Le-Bouillet and Huccorgne connection pipe. The contract includes the supply and laying of 8,550 m of PN 16 and PN 25 steel pipes, DN 800, 1,560 m of PVC DN 200 and 590 m of ductile iron DN80 and 100 mm. A 7 m passage under a river will be constructed – €9m
- **Eiffage Benelux (EIFFAGE)** : construction of new Defence headquarters in Brussels for the Ministry of Defence – €499m (*Eiffage share: 33% of the project's construction budget*)

Charging stations for electric vehicles and bicycles are also planned – €44m


